Place receptacles to curb the night before scheduled collection day

45 gallon receptacles, not to exceed 50lbs

There is no garbage or recycling pick up on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, or Christmas.

Brush Collection

- ***Brush only** can be put to the curb at any time January 1st through October 31st
- *The Department of Public Works will be picking up brush continually during this time
- *Branches must be no more than 4' in length and 12" in diameter
- *Christmas trees can be placed to curb at any time during the brush collection period

Leaf Collection

- ***Leaves only** can be put to the curb from November 4th through December 27th
- *The Department of Public Works will be picking up leaves continually during this time
- *Please do not mix brush and leaves, as per state law they must be recycled separately
- *Please help us with drainage and do not place brush or leaves within 10 feet of a storm drain
